

Newmont and Nevada Mining Delegation: Sydney Smart Mining Event

The USA already is one of the top 5 export destinations for Australian METS and is in the sights of many this year, with the world's biggest mining exhibition, MINExpo, taking place in Las Vegas, Nevada, in September. Nevada, a state not unlike Western Australia in its vast and arid landscape, is home to 48 operating metals and minerals mines. Newmont Mining, Barrick Gold, Allied Gold, Kinross, Goldcorp and numerous junior miners are present, mining a variety of commodities, including gold, copper, lithium and molybdenum.

Ahead of MINExpo, a delegation from Nevada is visiting Australia, keen to explore the use of **new technology** in the mining sector, discuss and explore the environmental impact of mining, particularly in relation to **water**, learn from Australia's success in **gender diversity** and discuss the social impact and license for mining as it relates to the **environment, communities, minorities and indigenous people**.

This event will feature two key presentations providing insights into the Nevada market and specific challenges of miners in the state, along with a panel discussion where attendees will have the chance to ask specific questions of the delegation.
